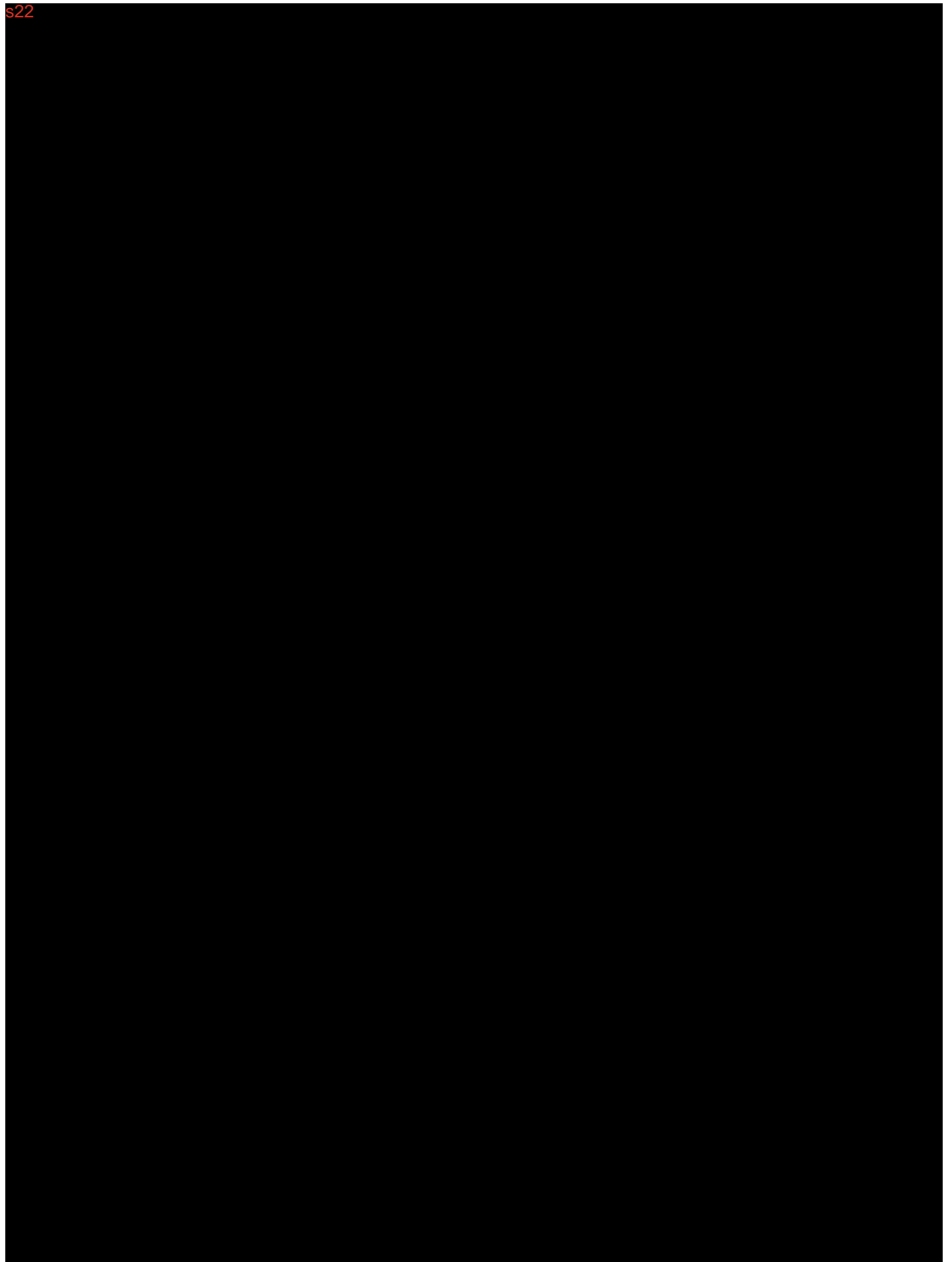


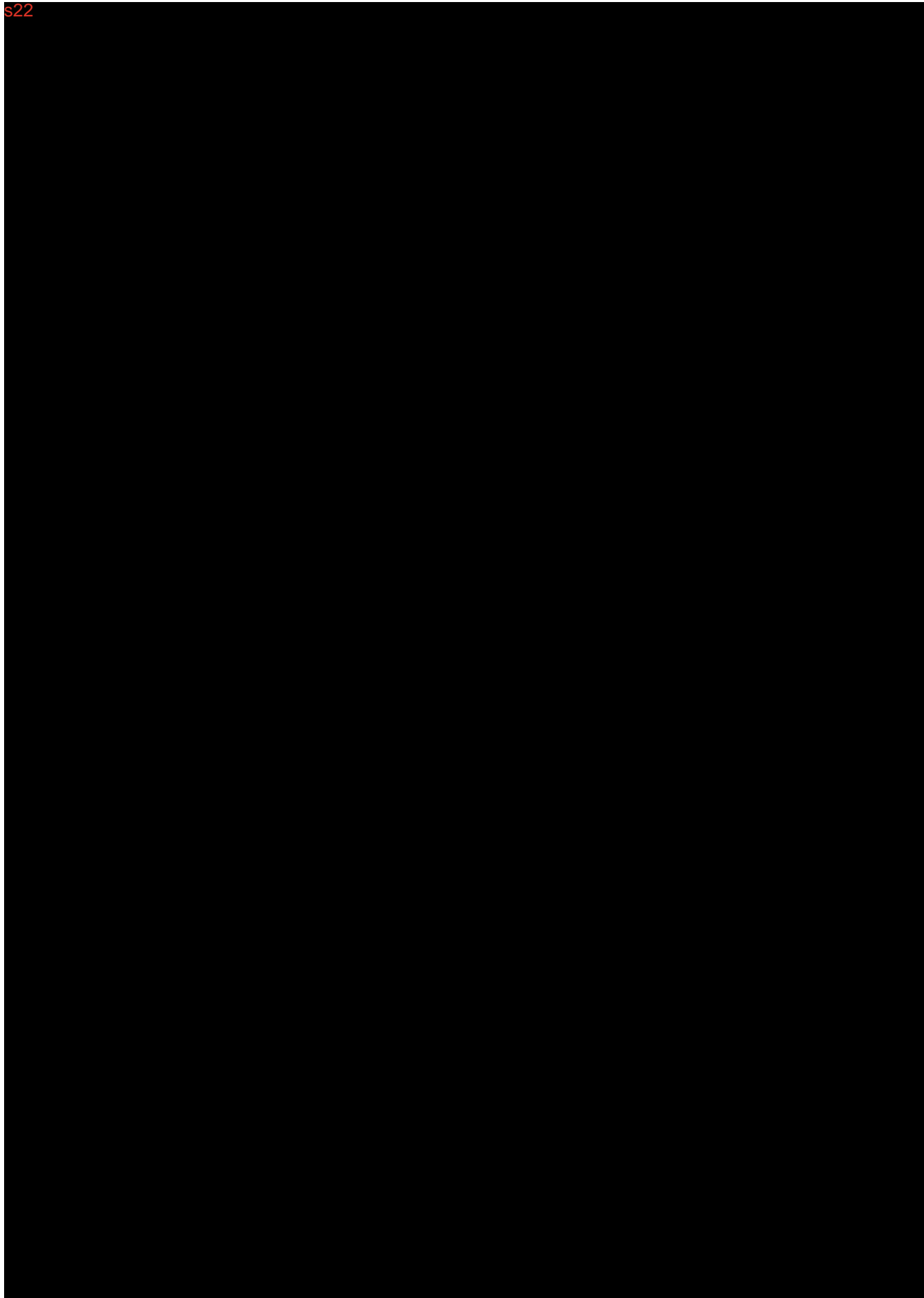


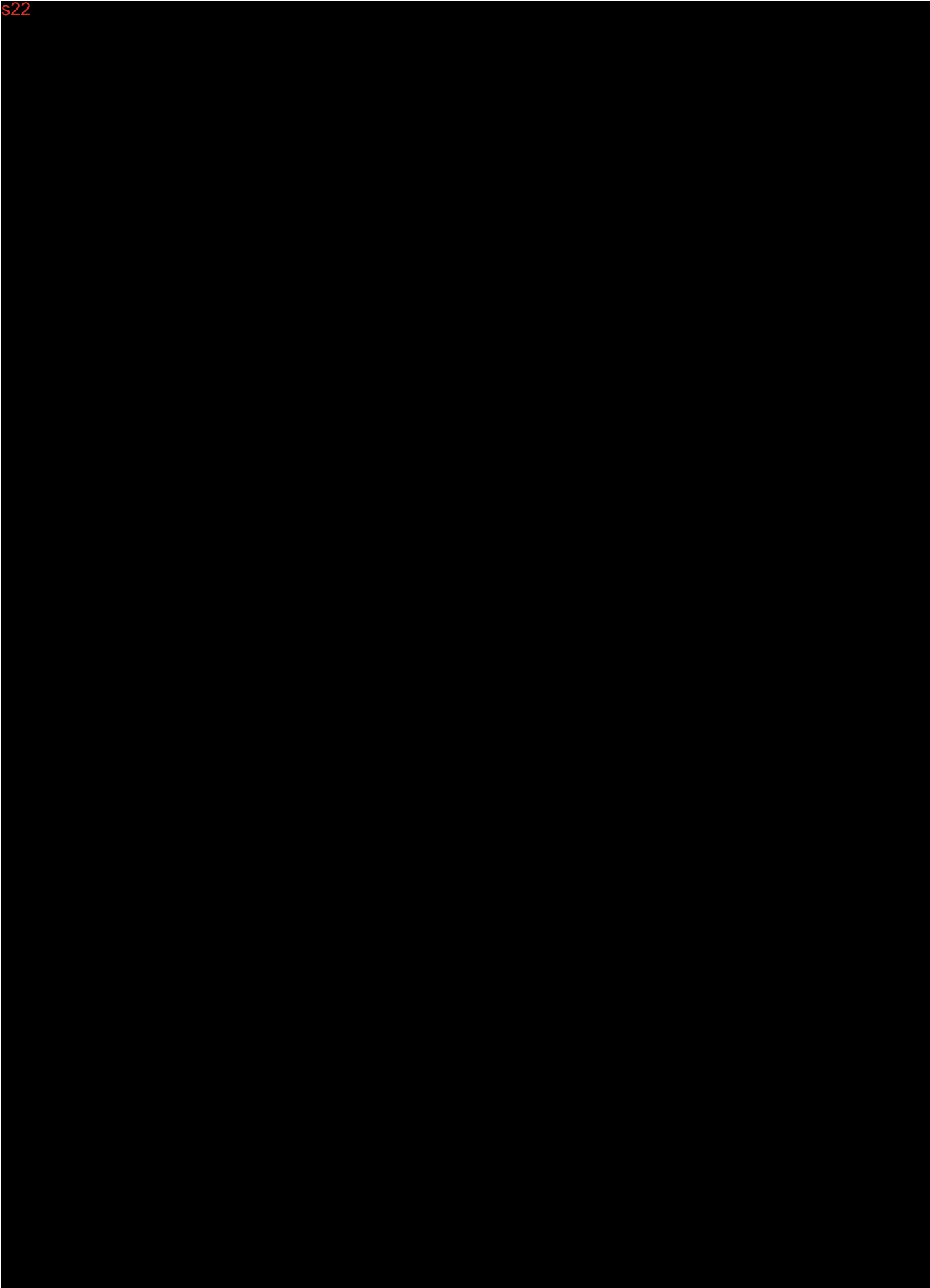


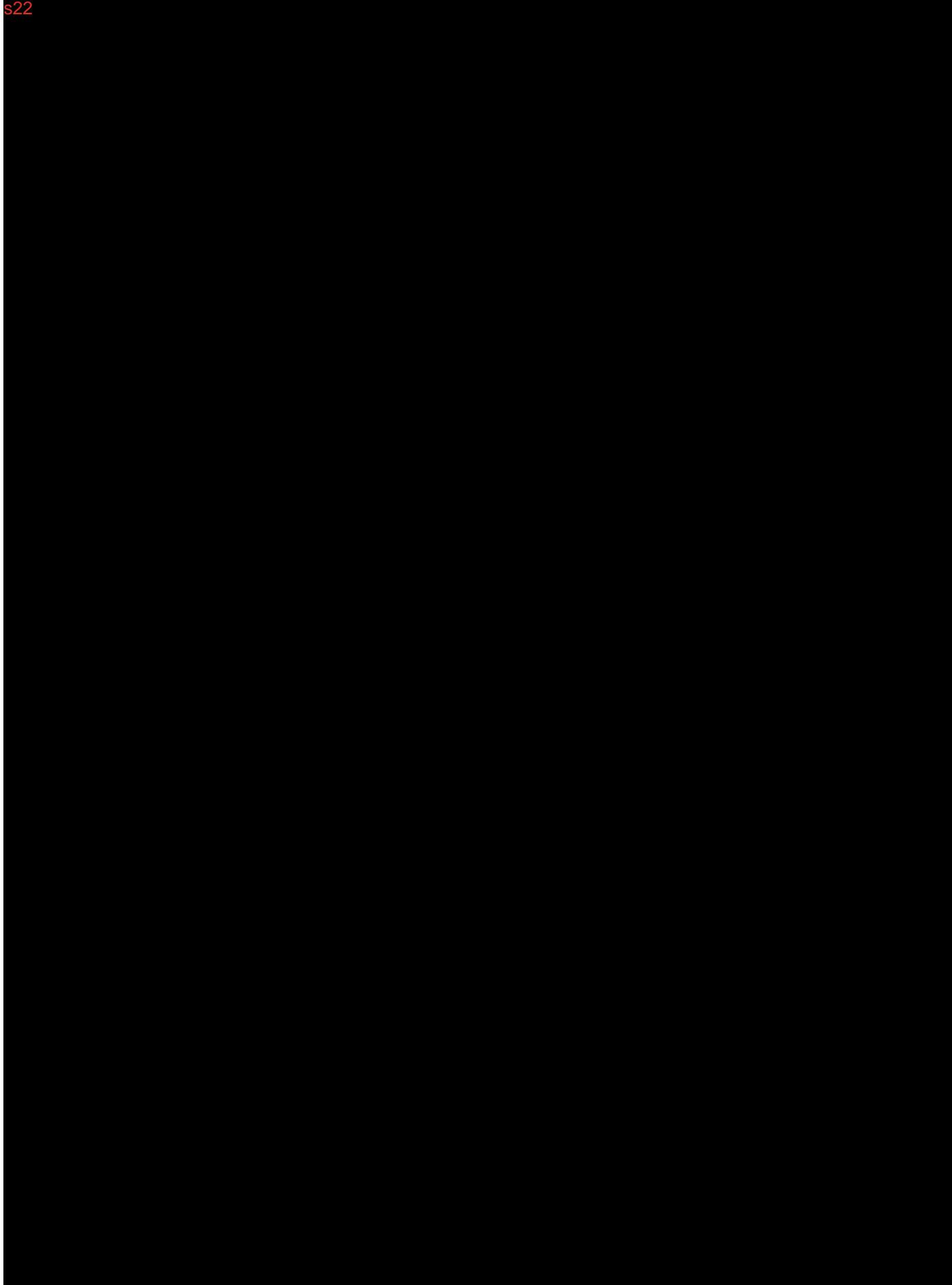


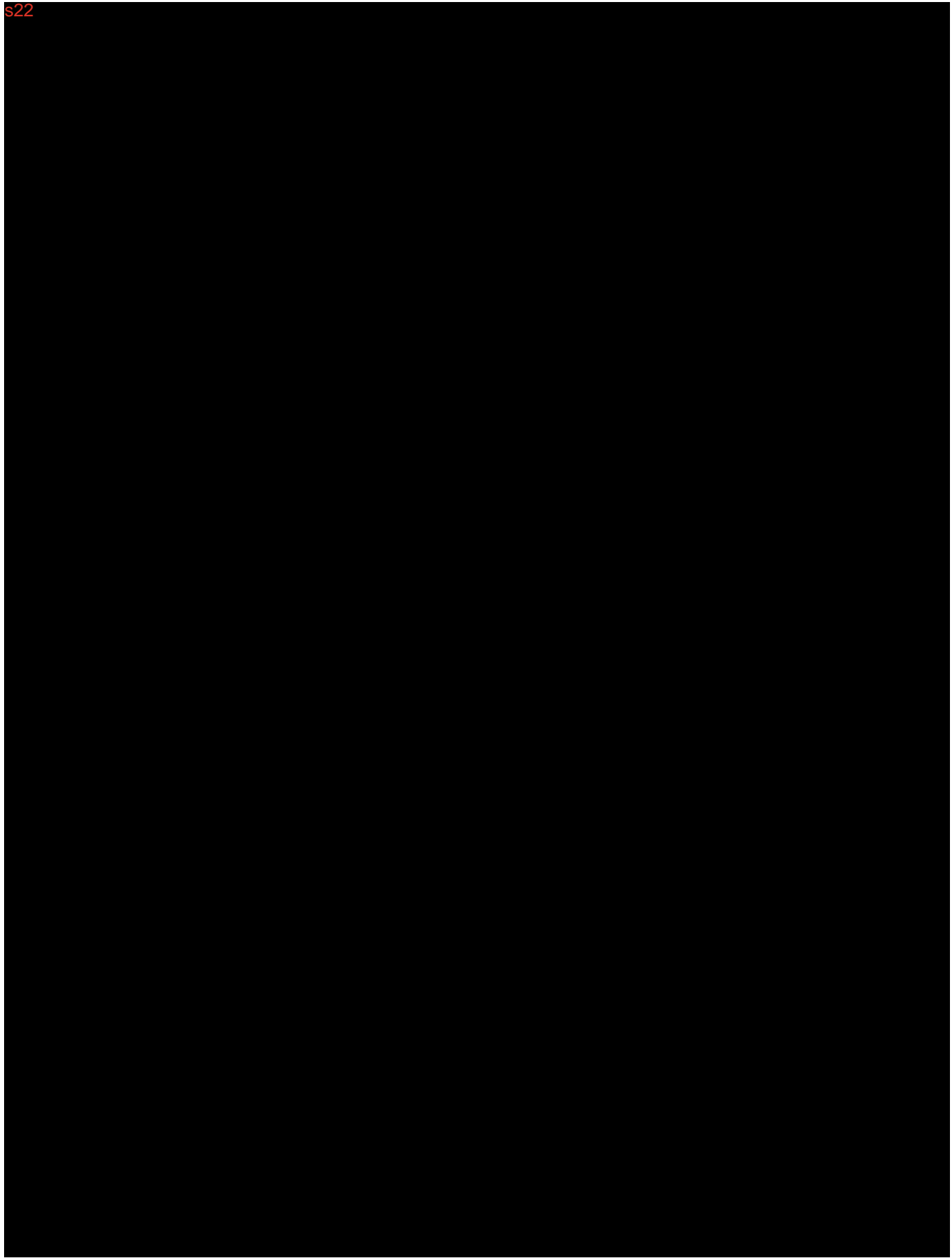


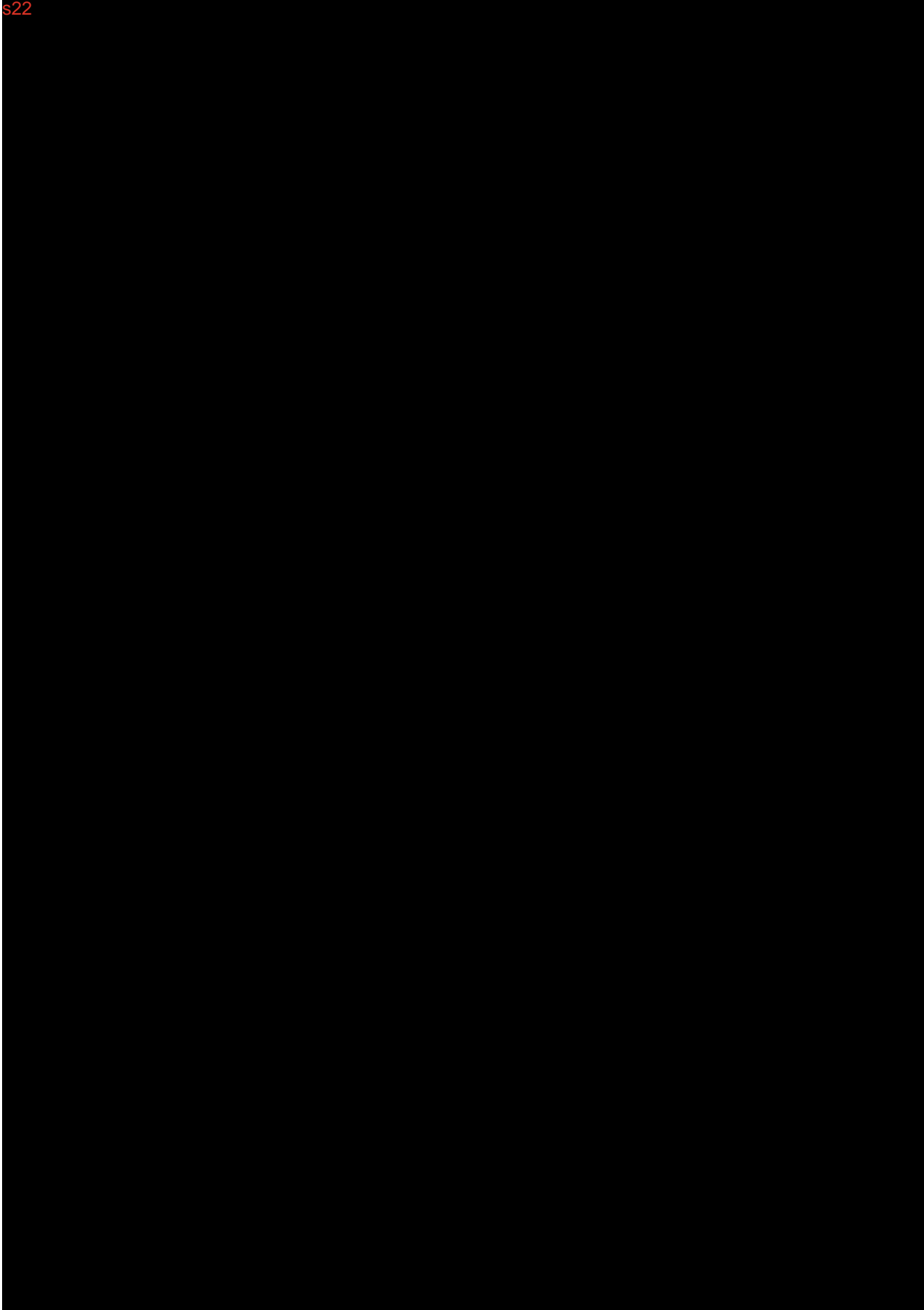


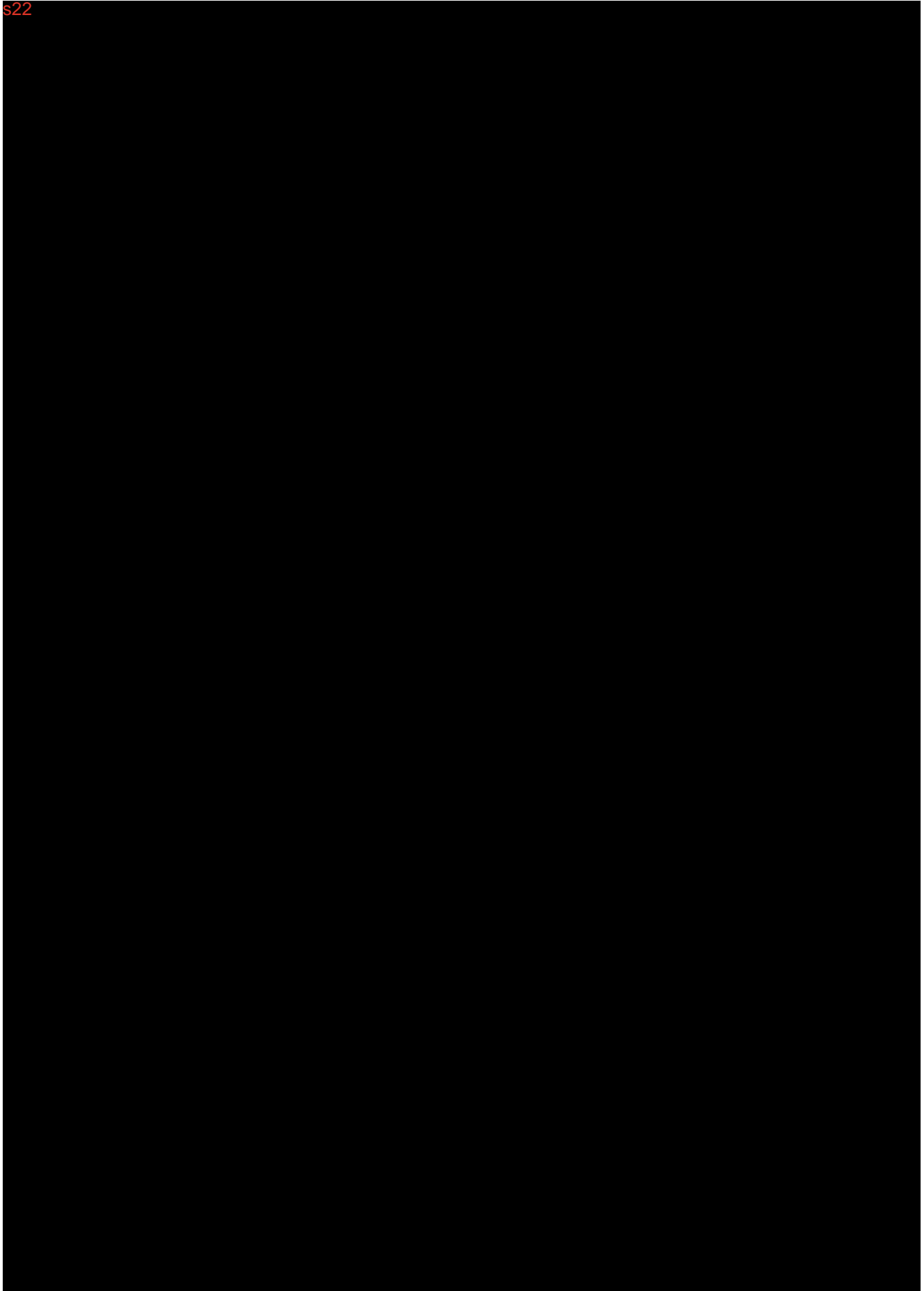


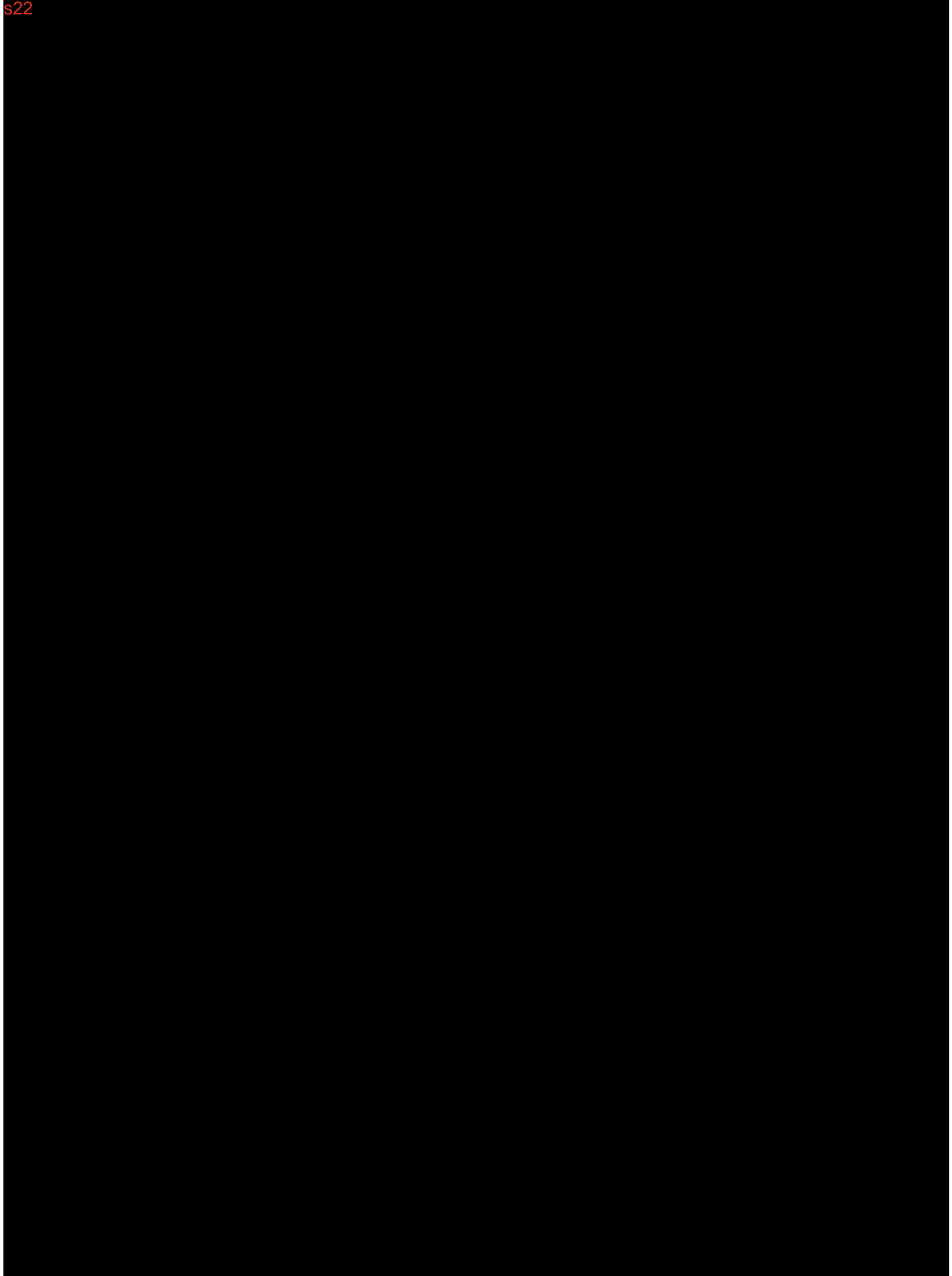


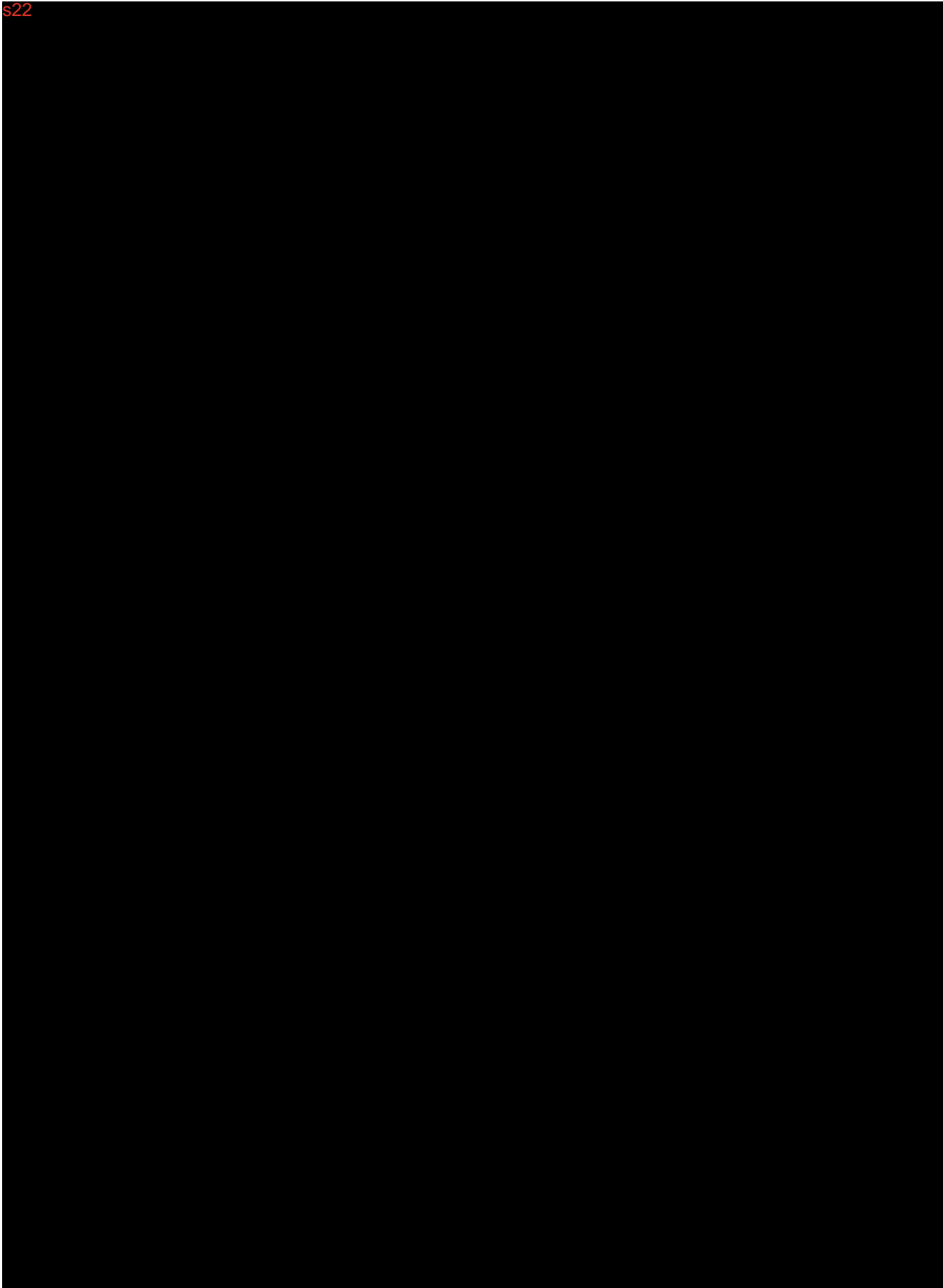


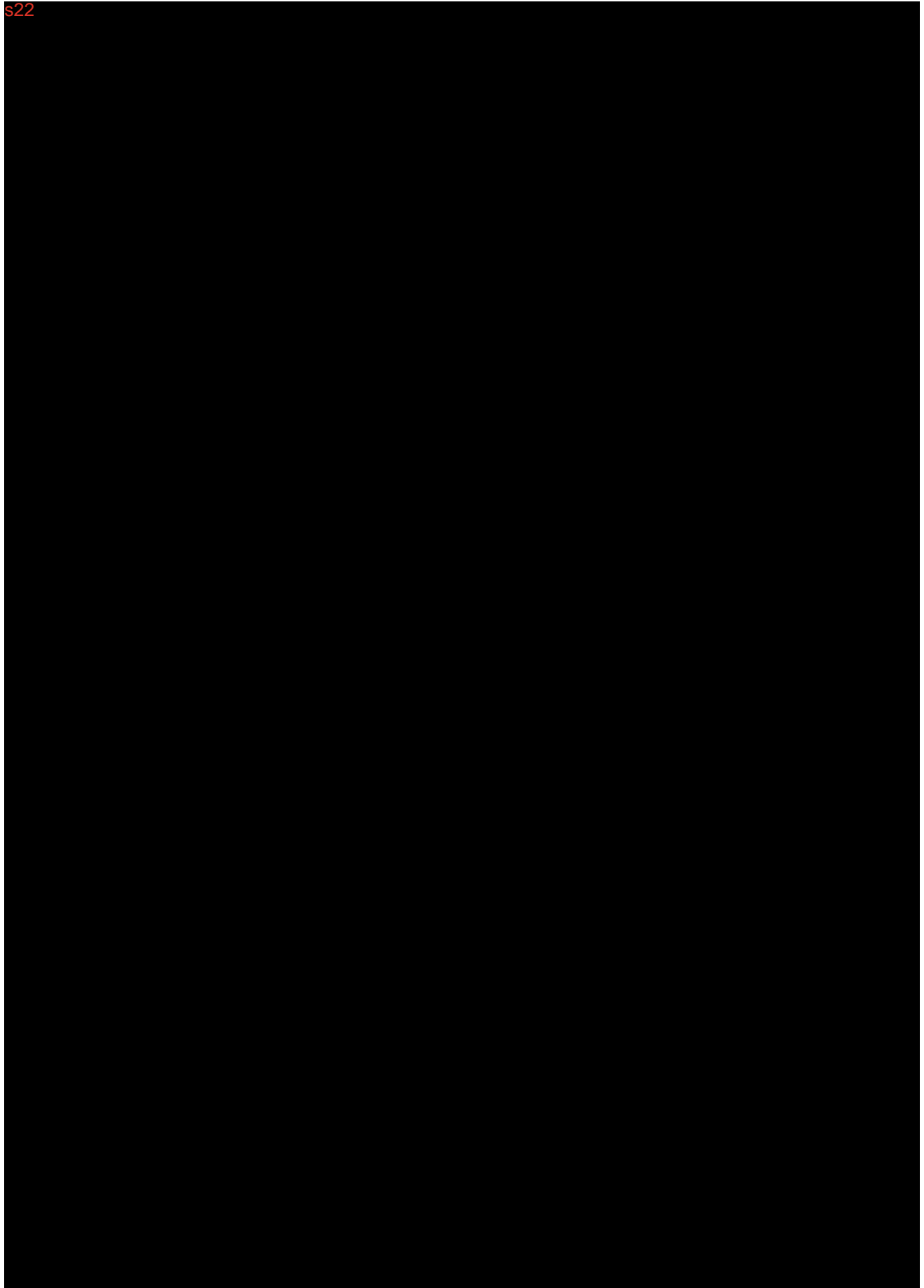


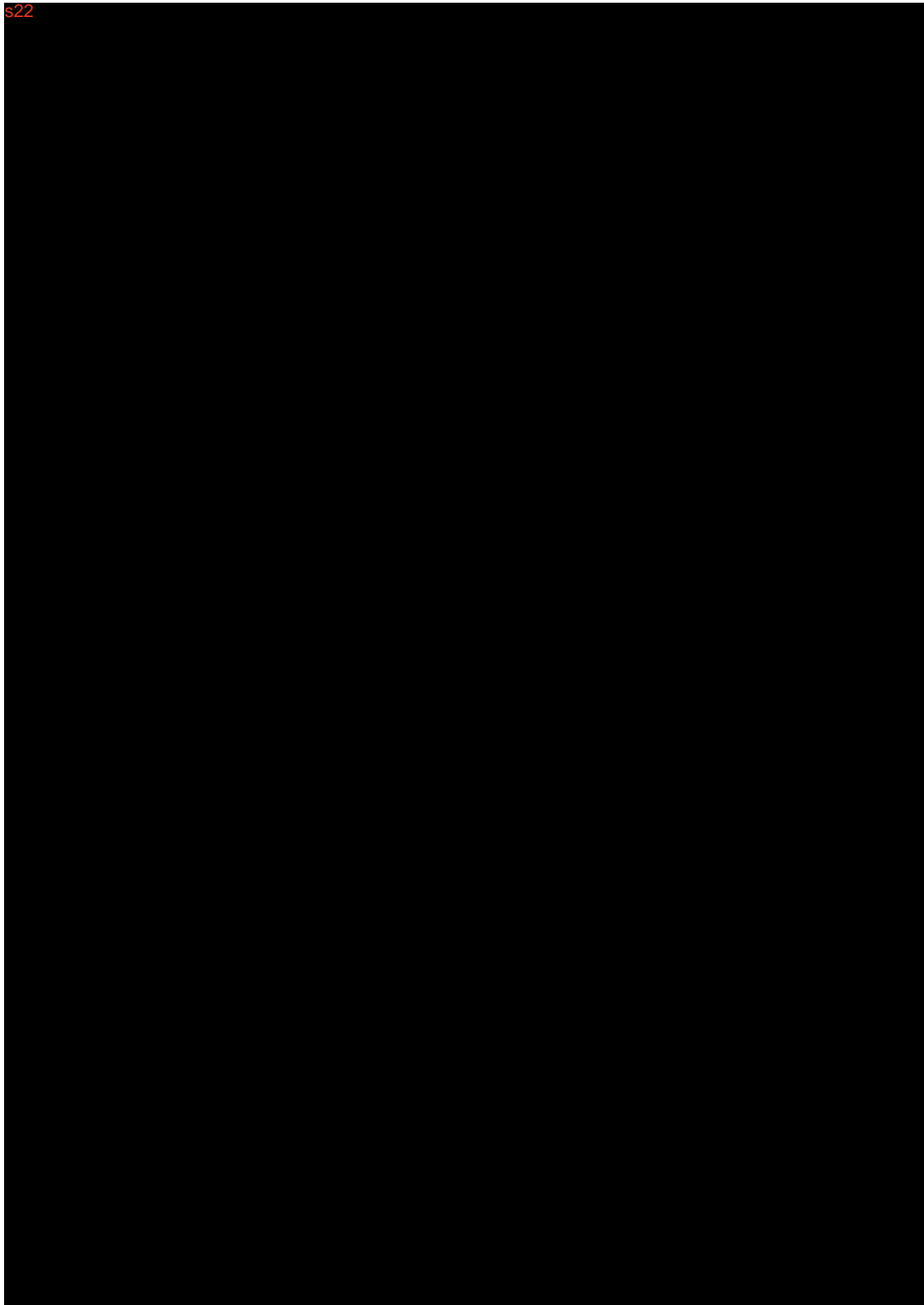


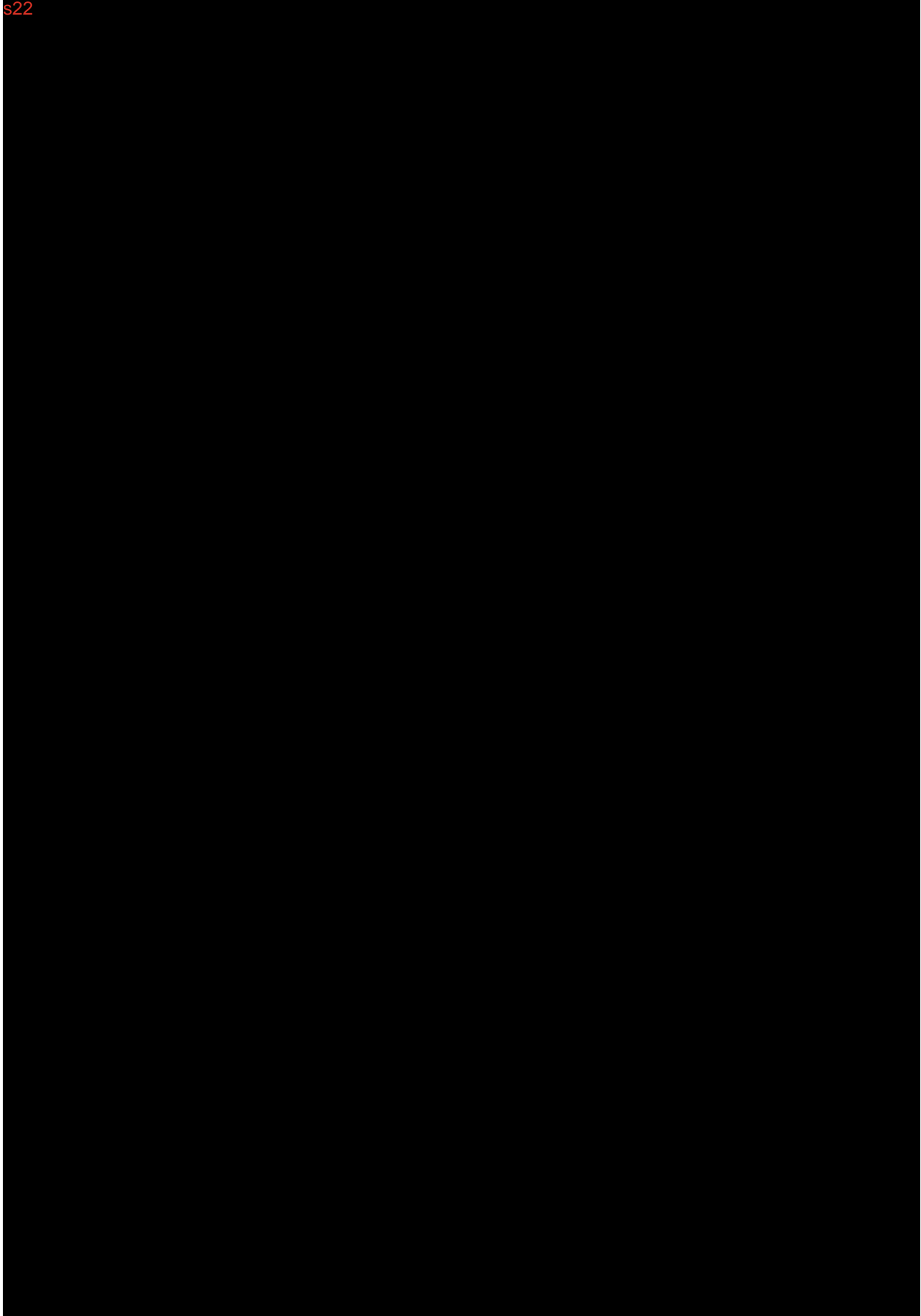


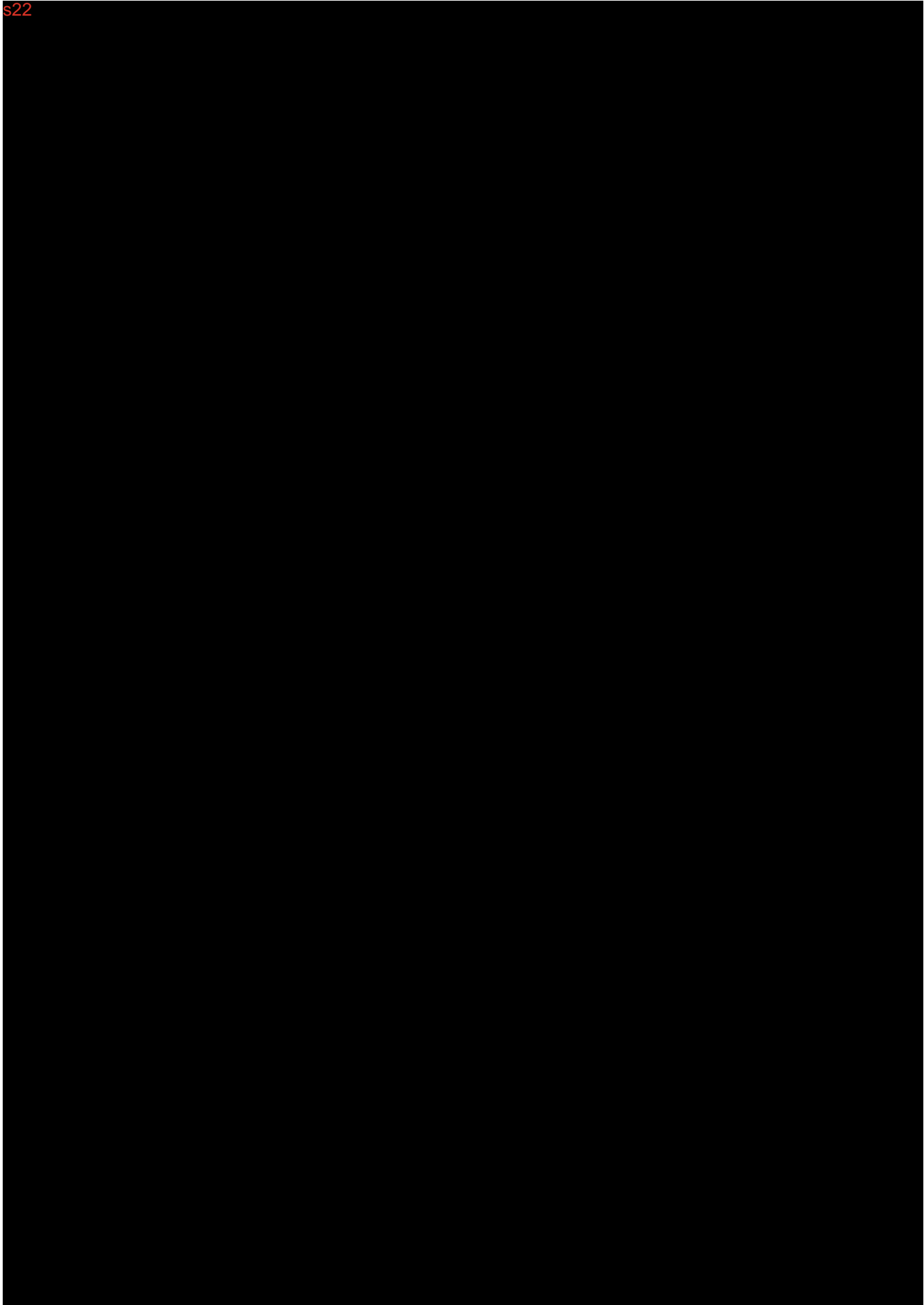


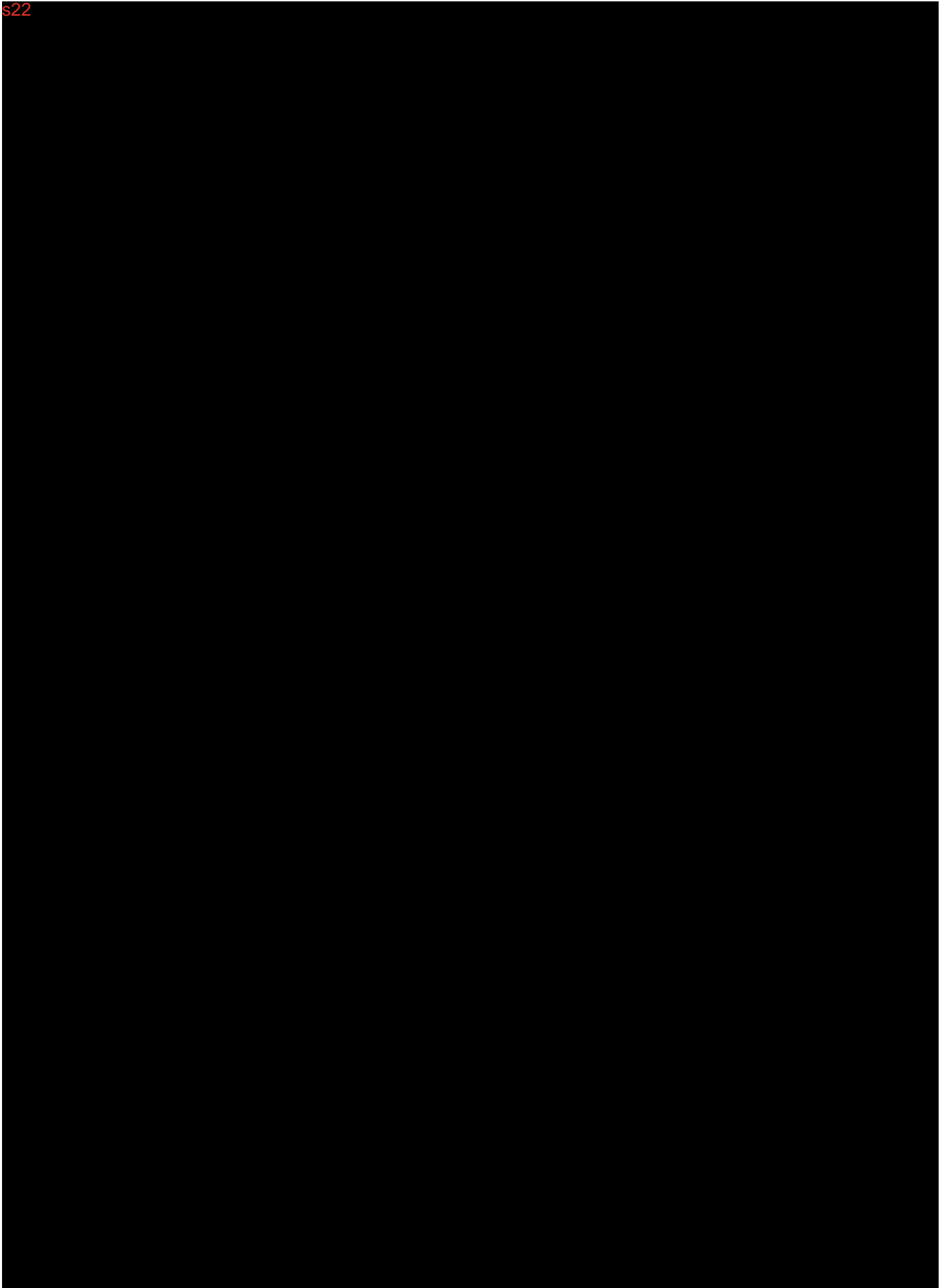












10. Charges and payment

10.1 Charges

10.1.1 The **charges** are set out in **Schedule G** and, subject to **seller's** performance of its obligations in accordance with the contract, are payable by **buyer** in accordance with this clause 10 and **Schedule G**.

10.1.2 The **charges** may be based on one or more of the following:

- a) time;
- b) unit;
- c) **payment milestones**;
- d) any other basis specified in **Schedule G**.

10.2 Invoices

10.2.1 After **acceptance** of a **deliverable** or **delivery milestone**, or as otherwise specified in **Schedule G**, **seller** must promptly deliver to **buyer** at the

invoice address specified in Item 26 of **Schedule B** a **correctly rendered invoice** covering the **charges** payable.

10.3 Payment

10.3.1 **buyer** will make payment within 30 days of receiving a **correctly rendered invoice**, unless a different period is specified in **Schedule G**.

10.3.2 The **parties** agree that payments may be effected by electronic funds transfer in accordance with **Schedule G**, or as otherwise agreed.

10.3.3 If the **parties** dispute whether any amount included in an invoice is payable, **buyer** may withhold the disputed portion until the dispute is resolved but will pay the undisputed portion within the period specified in clause 10.3.1.

10.4 GST and other taxes

10.4.1 All **taxes** imposed or levied in Australia or overseas in connection with this contract will be the responsibility of **seller**.

10.4.2 In this clause 10.4, a word or expression defined in the **GST Act** has the meaning given to it in that Act.

10.4.3 If a **party (supplier)** makes a supply under or in connection with this contract in respect of which GST is payable, the recipient of the supply must pay to the **supplier**, an additional amount equal to the GST payable on the supply.

10.5 Maximum charges payable

10.5.1 Notwithstanding any other provision of this contract (other than clause 10.6) **buyer** has no liability to pay **charges** to **seller** to the extent that those **charges** exceed the **maximum charges payable**.

10.6 Late payment of invoices

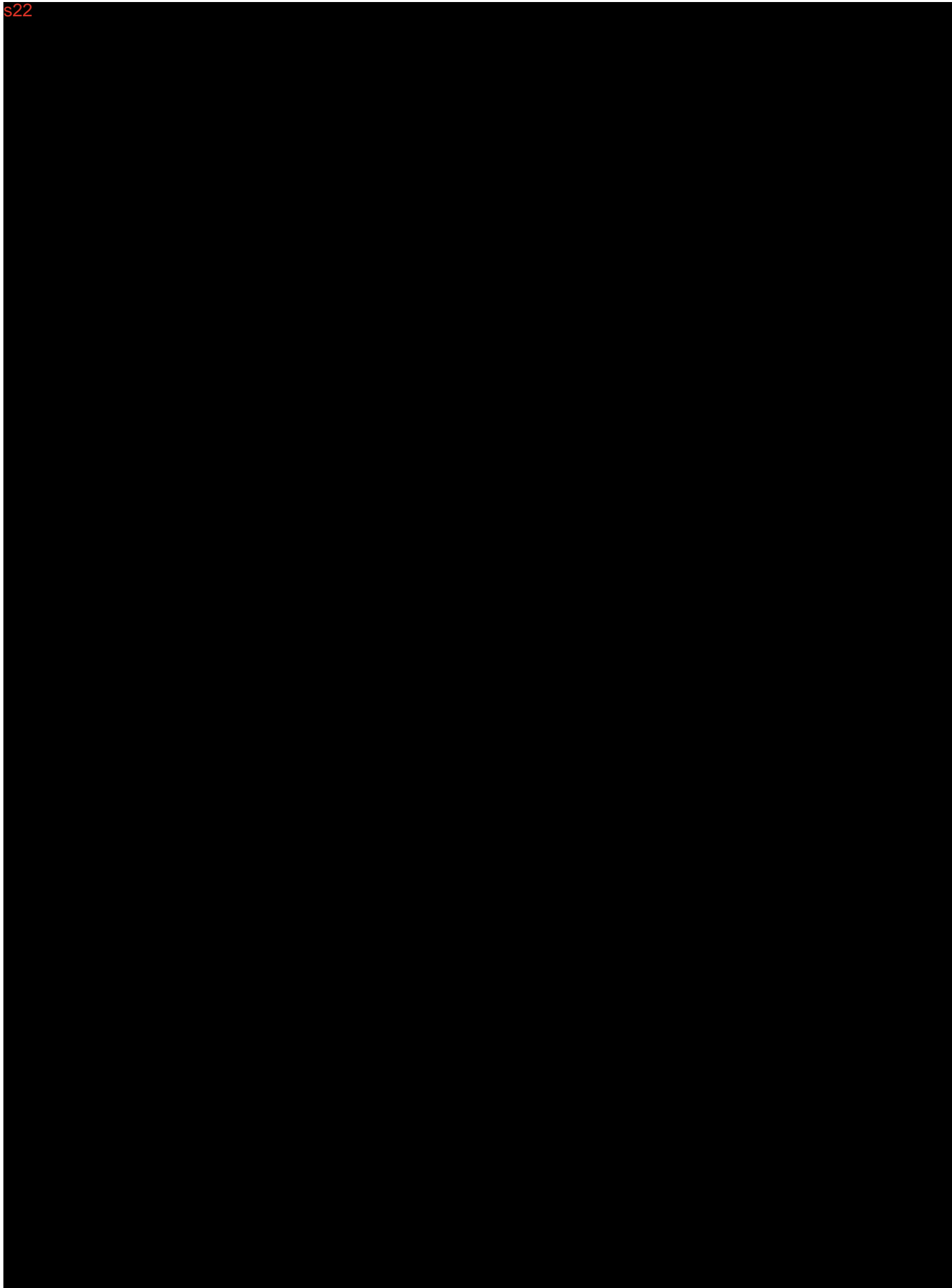
- a) If the seller is required to submit an invoice to trigger payment, the invoice must be a Correctly Rendered Invoice.
- b) The seller must promptly provide to the buyer such supporting documentation and other evidence reasonably required by the buyer to substantiate performance of the Contract by the seller.
- c) Payment of any invoice is payment on account only, and does not substantiate performance of the Contract.
- d) If the seller owes any amount to the buyer in connection with the Contract, the buyer may offset that amount, or part of it, against its obligation to pay any Correctly Rendered Invoice.
- e) Where the buyer and the seller both have the capability to deliver and receive eInvoices through the Peppol framework and have agreed to use electronic invoicing (eInvoicing), the buyer will pay the seller within five (5) calendar days, unless shorter payment terms are agreed, following the acknowledgment of the satisfactory delivery of the goods or services and receipt of a correctly rendered invoice. If this period ends on a day that is not a Business Day, payment is due the next Business Day.
- f) Where clause 10.6 e does not apply, and shorter payment terms have not been agreed, the buyer will pay the seller within twenty (20) calendar days, following the acknowledgment of the satisfactory

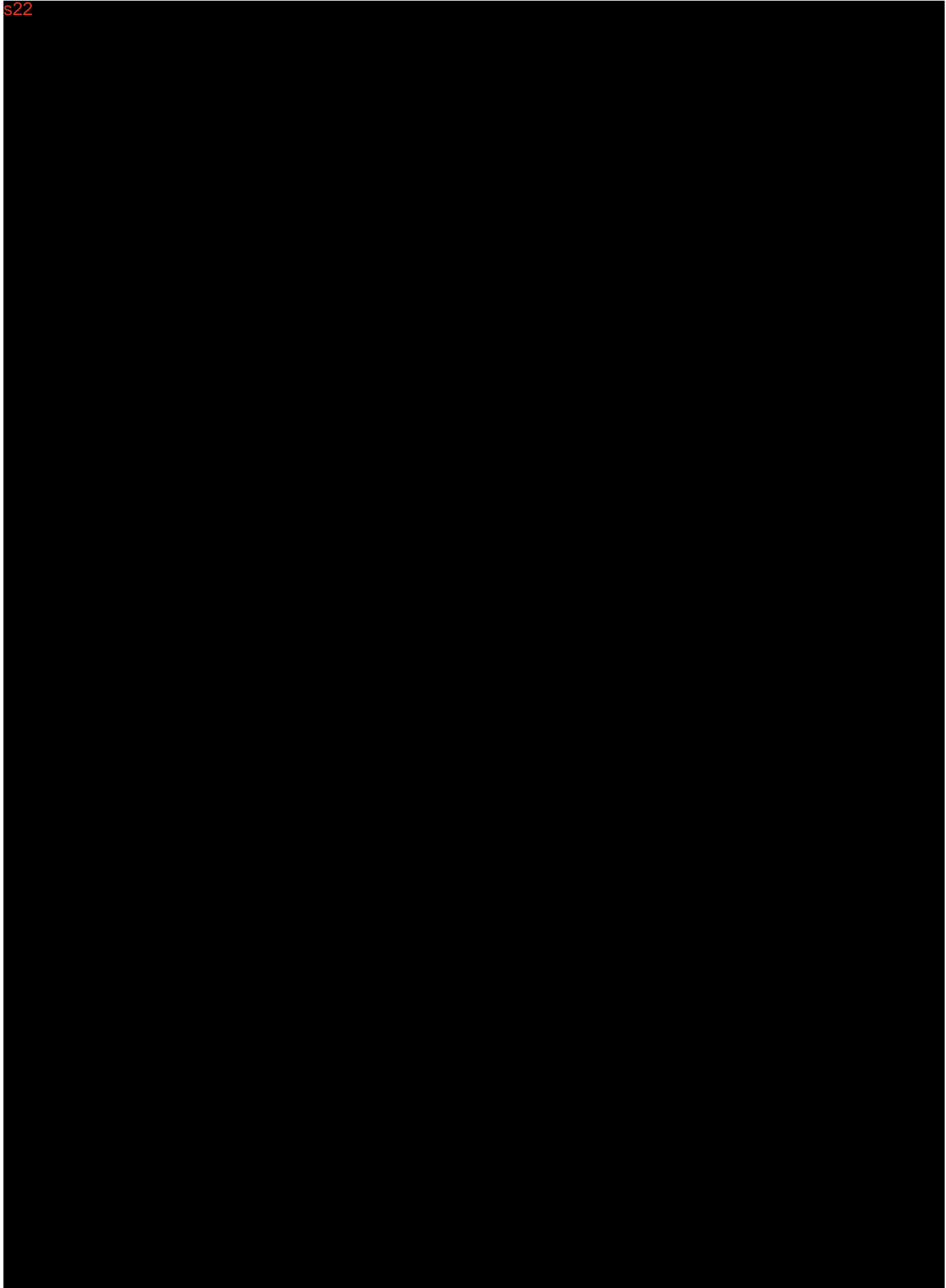
delivery of the goods or services and receipt of a correctly rendered invoice. If this period ends on a day that is not a Business Day, payment is due the next Business Day.

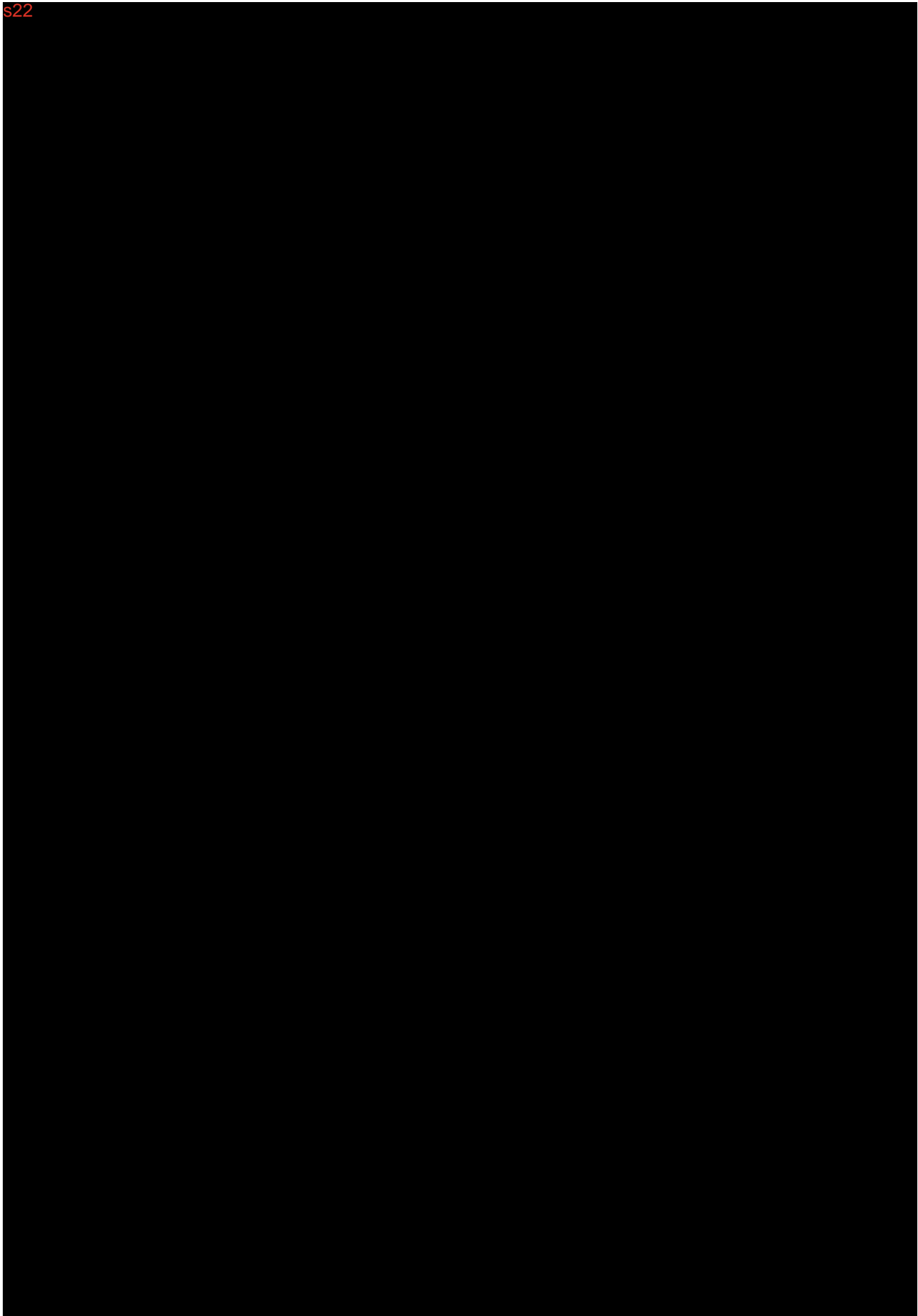
- g) Where the buyer fails to make a payment to the seller by the business day it is due, the buyer will pay the unpaid amount plus interest on the unpaid amount, provided the amount of interest payable under this clause exceeds A\$100.
- h) Interest payable under this clause will be simple interest calculated in respect of each calendar day from the day after the amount was due and payable, up to and including the day that the buyer effects payment, calculated using the General Interest Charge Rate available on the Australian Taxation Office website as it appears/applies on the day the amount was due and payable expressed as a daily rate.

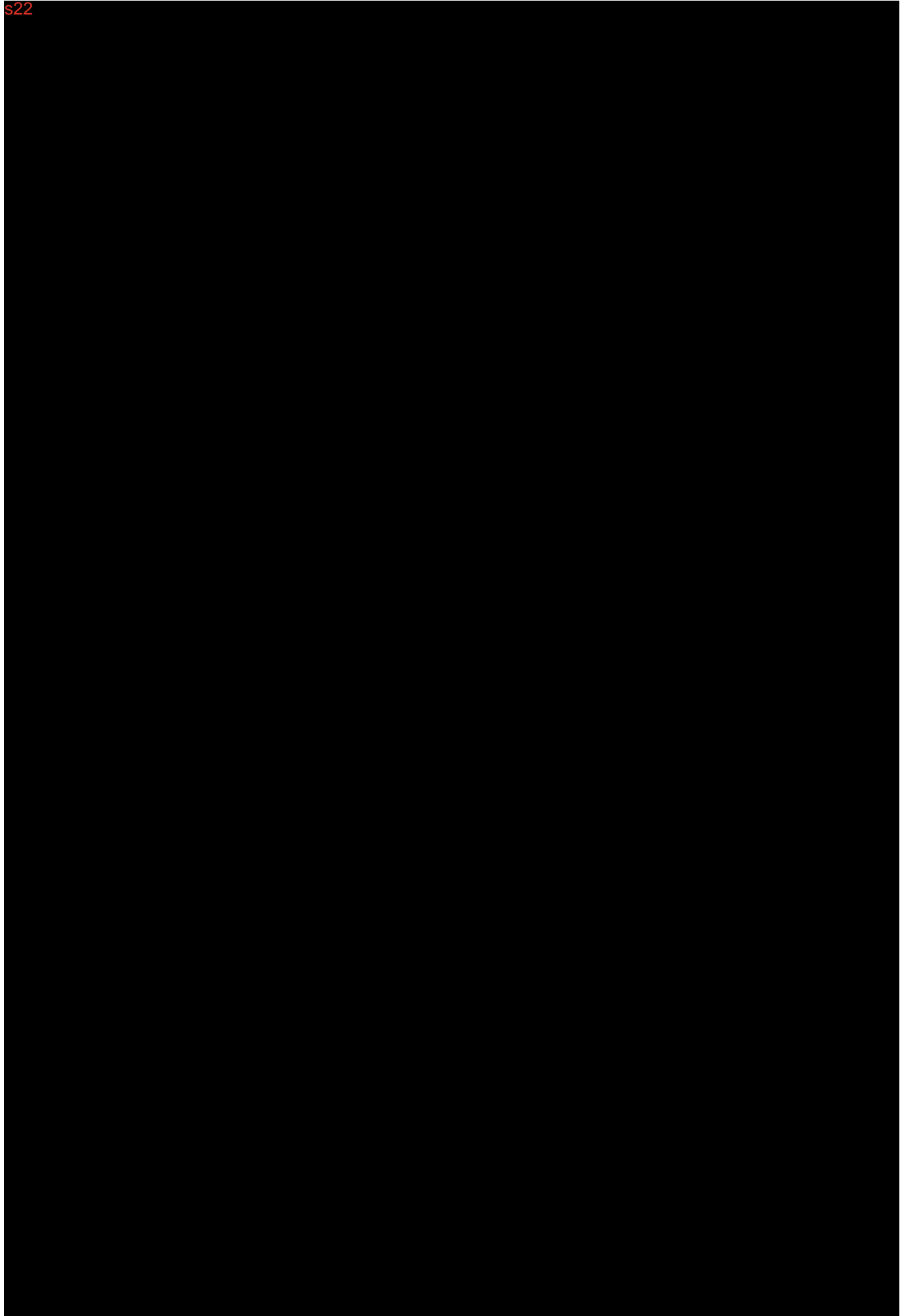
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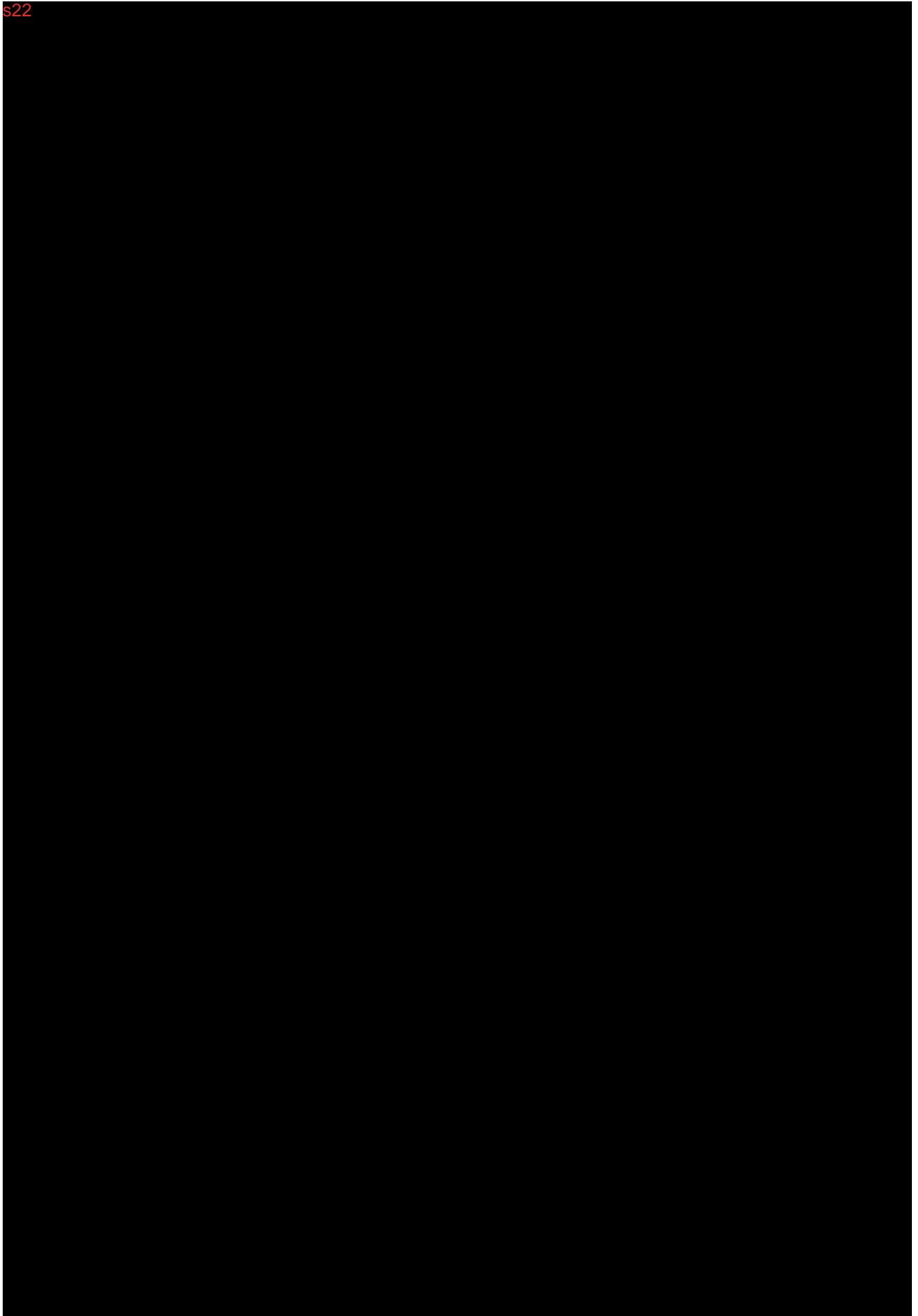


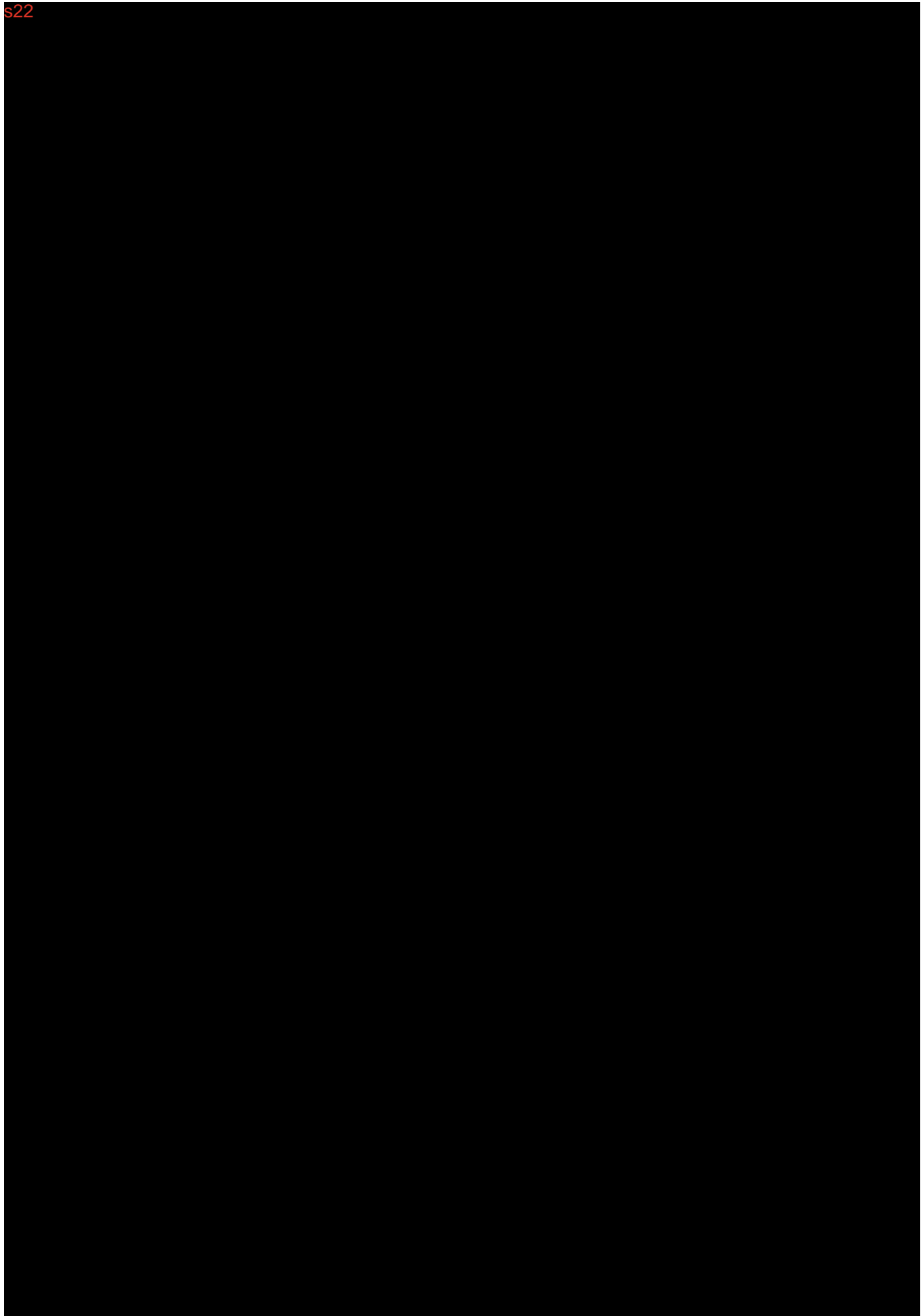


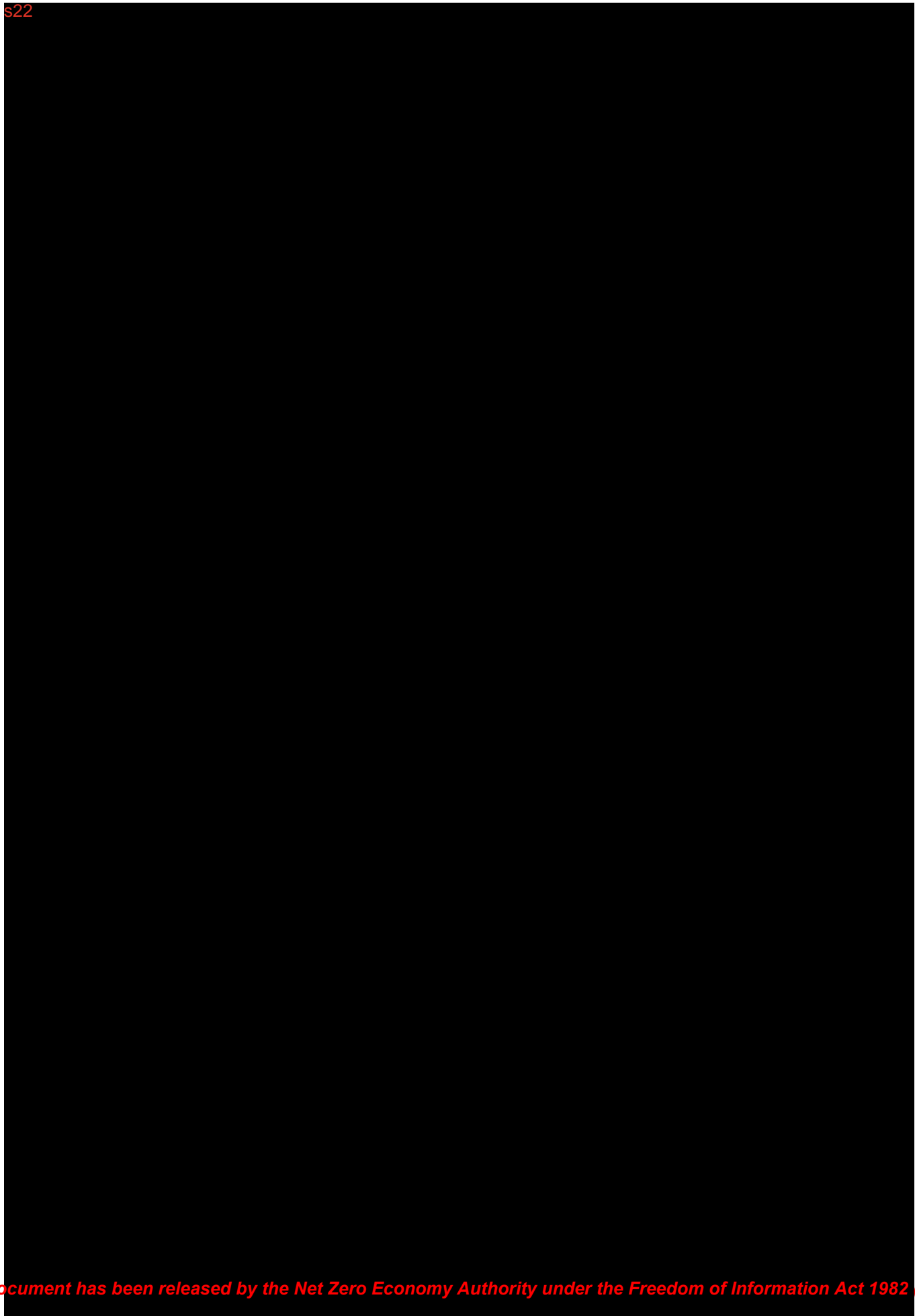


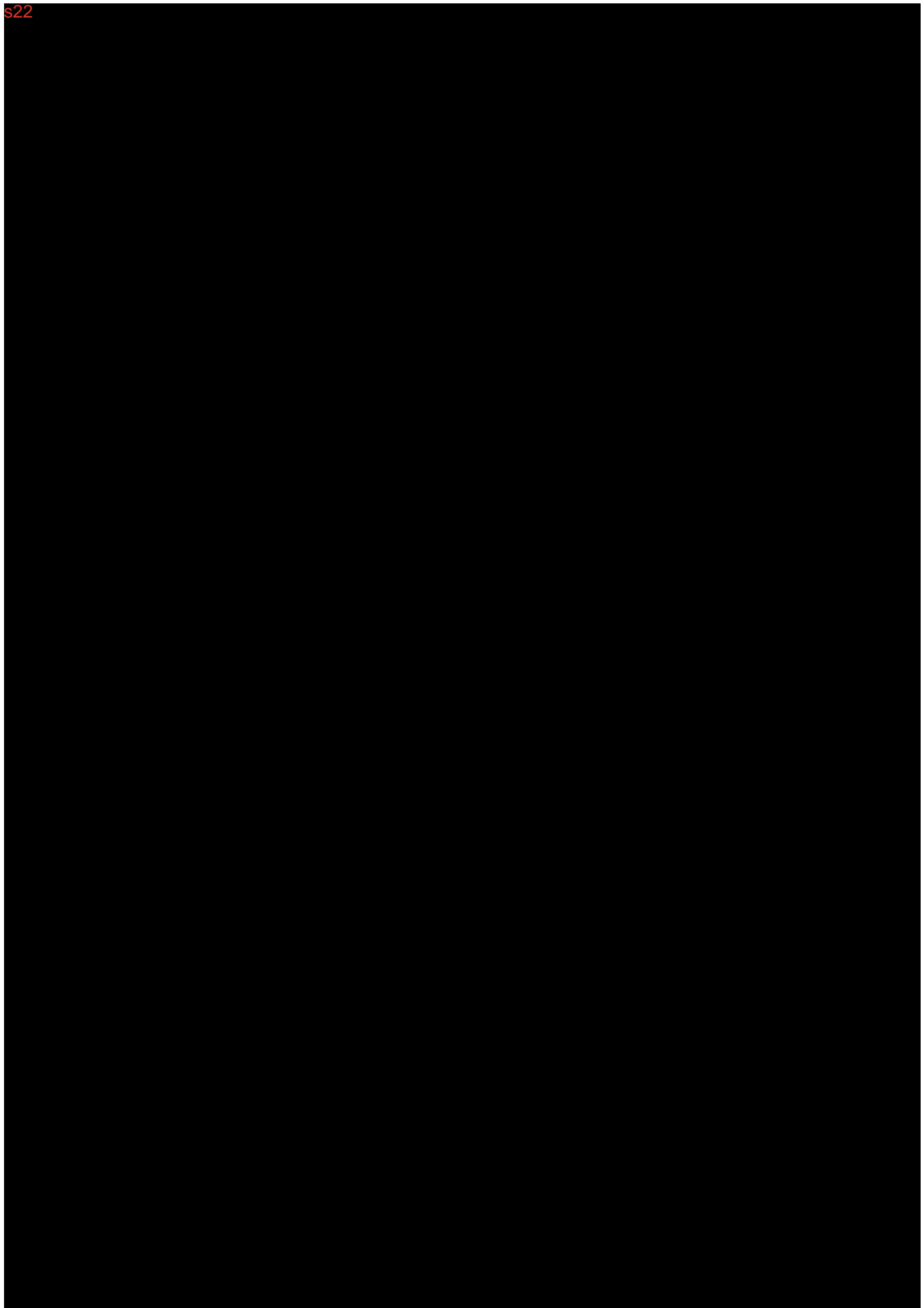












15. Changing and ending the contract

15.1 Variation

- 15.1.1 Other than as expressly provided in this contract, this contract may only be varied in writing, signed by the **parties**. **buyer** is not responsible for any additional **charges** or for any additional costs incurred by **seller** in relation to a proposed variation until the variation is recorded in writing and is signed by the **parties**.
- 15.1.2 If a **party** proposes a change to the contract, that **party** must complete **Schedule H** in relation to the proposed change and include the completed change order in a **notice** to the other **party** for that **party's** consideration.
- 15.1.3 If a limitation of liability amount is included at Item 34 of **Schedule B** and the risks relating to this contract for a **party** would increase or decrease as a result of a proposed variation of this contract, the **parties** must negotiate in good faith (as part of negotiations for the variation) to increase or decrease the limitation of liability amount to reflect the changed risks.
- 15.1.4 Each **party** must meet its own costs of varying the contract under this clause 15.1.

15.2 Buyer directions

- 15.2.1 If **buyer** (acting reasonably) considers that **seller** will not meet, or has not met, its obligations under this contract, **buyer** may give **seller** a reasonable direction in a **notice** to minimise the impact of **seller's** actual or prospective breach of this contract on **buyer**. **seller** must comply with any direction given by **buyer** under this clause 15.2.1.

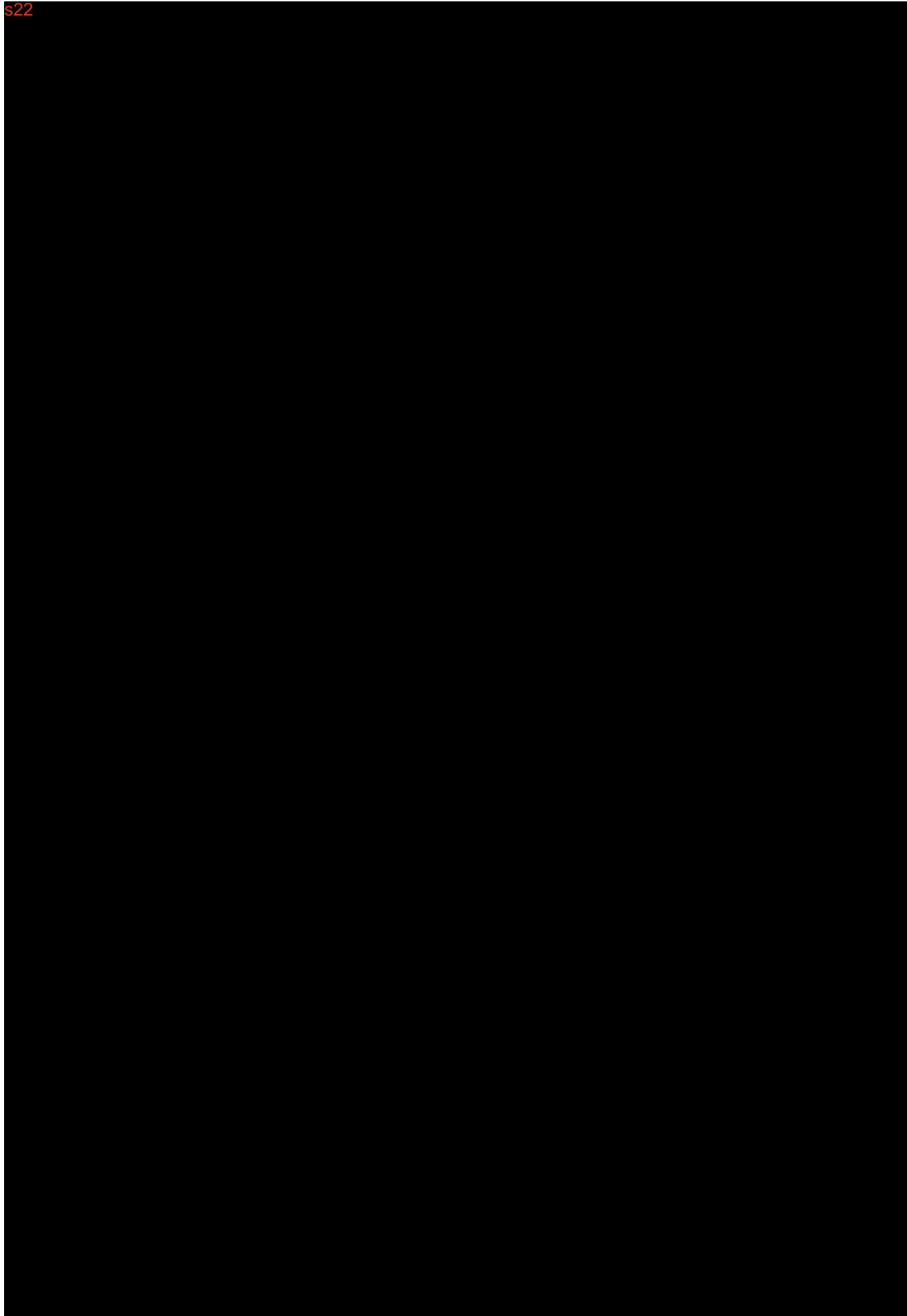
15.3 Pricing contract variations

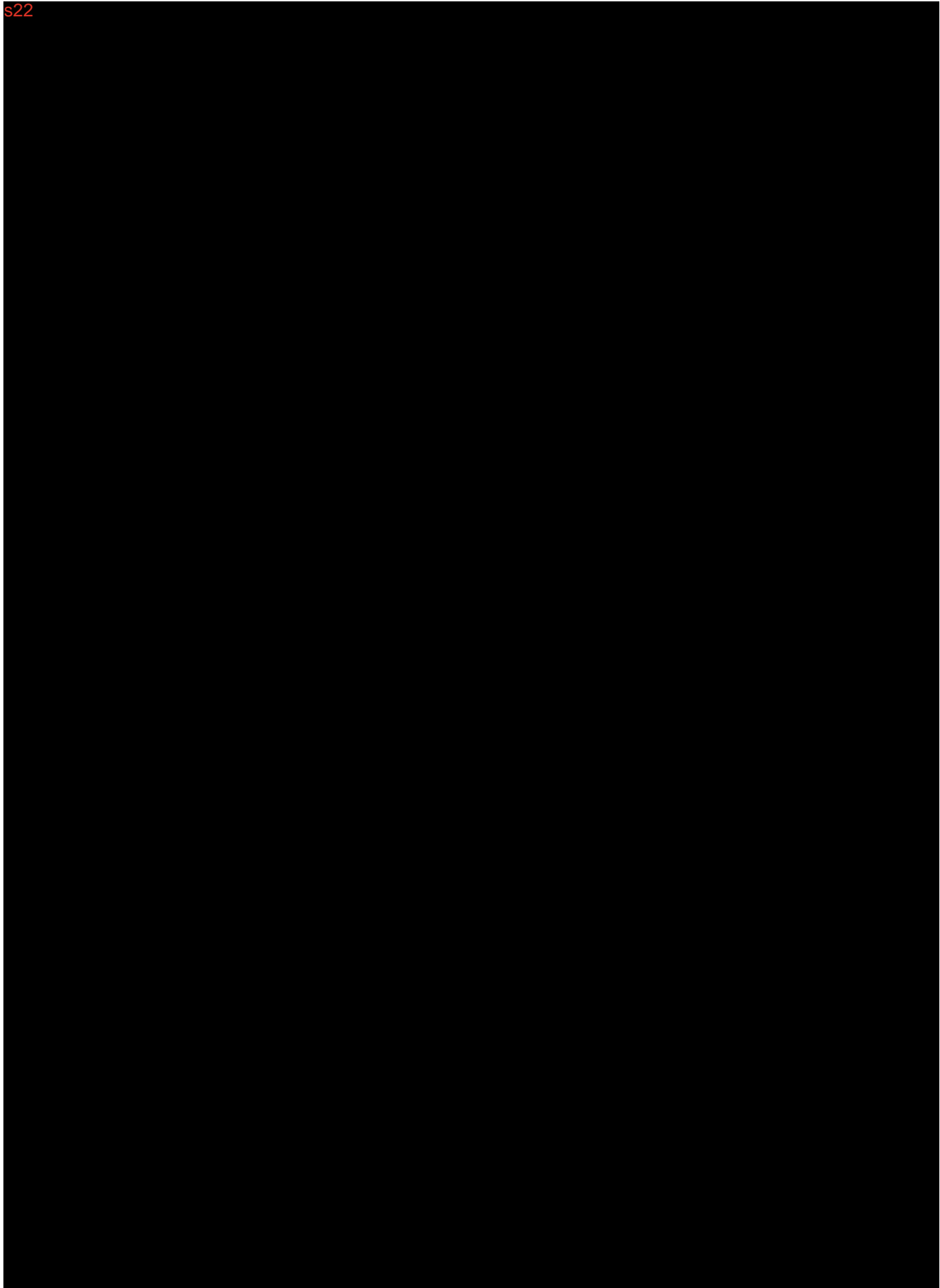
- 15.3.1 **seller** may only propose increased **charges** for a contract variation when completing **Schedule H** under clause 15.1.2 if the proposed variation would involve **seller** incurring additional costs, compared to the costs of performing the contract without the variation.
- 15.3.2 **seller** must ensure that such increased **charges** are reasonable, calculated on the same basis as **Schedule G** and, if requested by **buyer** in a **notice** to **seller**, substantiated.
- 15.3.3 If **Schedule G** includes a pricing mechanism for contract variations, **seller** must apply that mechanism when proposing increased **charges** for a

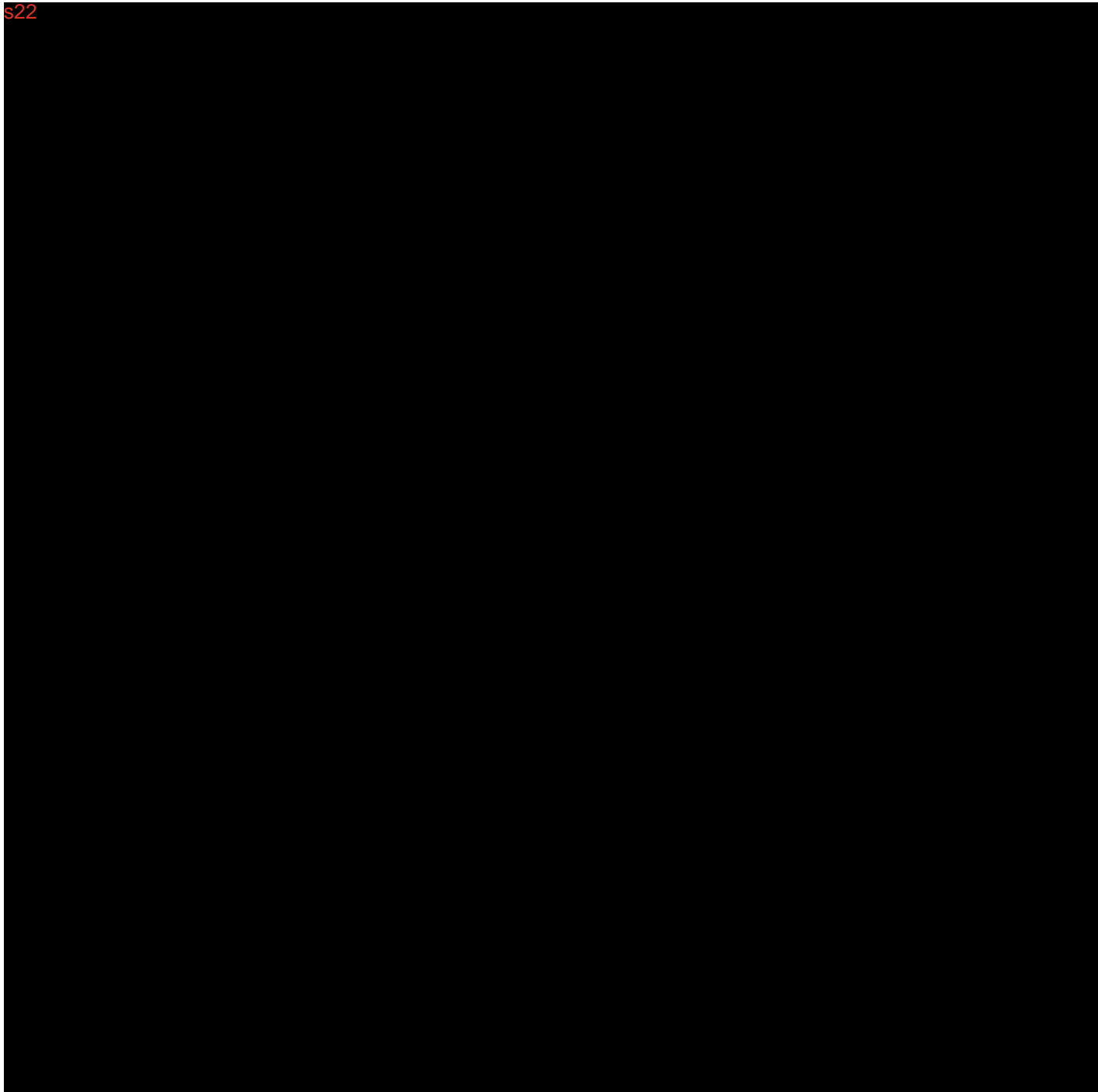

Proposed Scope

The Net Zero Investment Map will provide an online interactive map showing the location of net zero projects that have received Commonwealth funding and support. The map will be a useful tool for the three key stakeholder groups that the NZEA are looking to support through the energy transition, including workers, employers, businesses and investors.

Net Zero Investment Map's data and layers

Fundamentally, the data surfaced in the platform will projects or schemes where there has been Commonwealth funding or support committed, where those projects or schemes contribute to Australia's net zero transition. Data will be sourced from relevant Commonwealth websites and the information presented geospatially. Presenting the data in this fashion provides the user an information rich, single source of information.
